Reducing Anxiety in Your Life – pt.3

In the previous two newsletters, I said you can better manage the stress in your life by acknowledging the source of anxiety and reducing the unconscious sources of anxiety. The third thing you can do is: Engage your spirituality. Taking time to engage with the Eternal and the bigger purposes of life helps to reframe my world in its proper context. This may include spiritual practices like attending Mass or deep meditation. One practical thing I do is when I take a short work break, I consciously disconnect from people and technology and re-engage with God in guiet contemplation in nature. This settles me so that I can step back into the workflow with a clearer and less anxious perspective.
