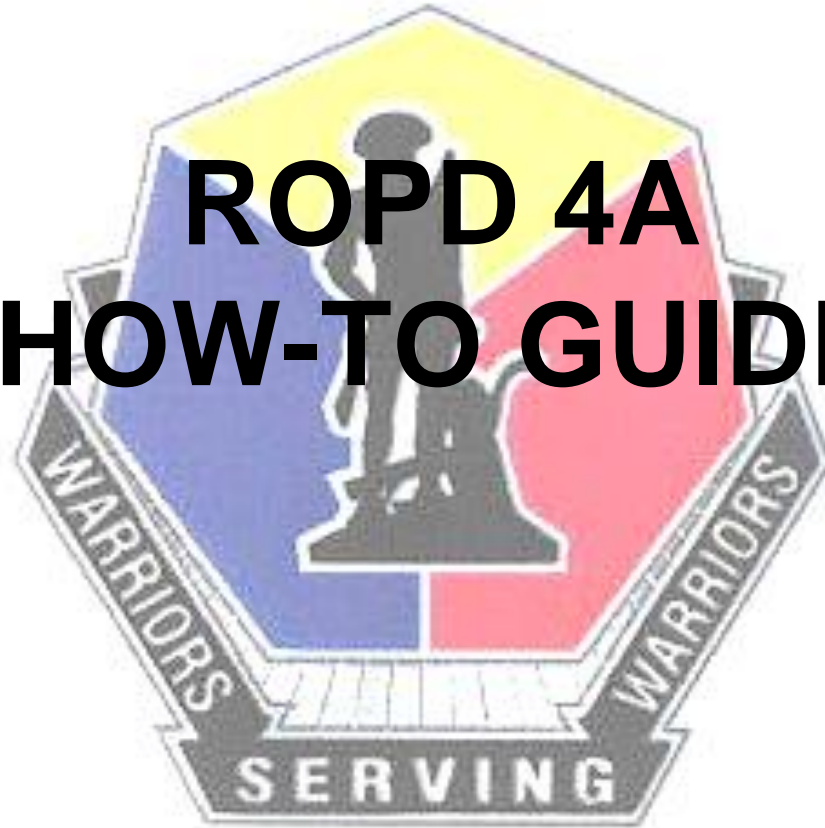

Range Operations Professional Development

- You can use “internet explorer” to complete the training until gone, Chrome and Edge do work.
- You can test out before you take the modules. If you fail, you will have to take the course (about 2 hours), there are 2 modules total
- Once completed, print and scan certificates and send to chain of command
- ROPD-4A must be submitted 30 days prior to range brief
- Some services members reported having issues printing at home
- SM’s must send the **OVERALL** certificate, not the module certificates.

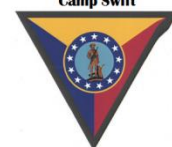

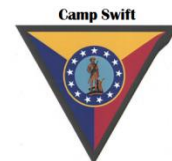
