TEXAS MILITARY DEPARTMENT PRIOR STATE EMPLOYMENT for LONGEVITY PAY

Current statutes provide for longevity pay to all full-time employees covered by the Position Classification Act of 1961, full-time item or exempt employees, regular full-time hourly employees and some other nonacademic employees of higher education. Longevity pay begins with two (2) years of state lifetime service credit and increases with each next two (2) year increment up to and including 42 years of service. Longevity pay is provided for employees who are full-time state employees on the first workday of the month, are not on leave without pay on the first workday of the month, and have at least two years of lifetime service credit accrued by the last day of the preceding month.
