MEMORANDUM FOR ALL NEW EMPLOYEES

SUBJECT: Reporting Workers Compensation Injuries

If you are injured on the job, even if you do not feel the need to see a doctor at that time, the injury must be reported within 3 days of the accident to the appropriate Workers' Compensation (WC) Coordinator.

The WC insurance carrier is State Office of Risk Management (SORM). SORM uses the CareNow Healthcare Network for medical treatment for work-related injuries.
