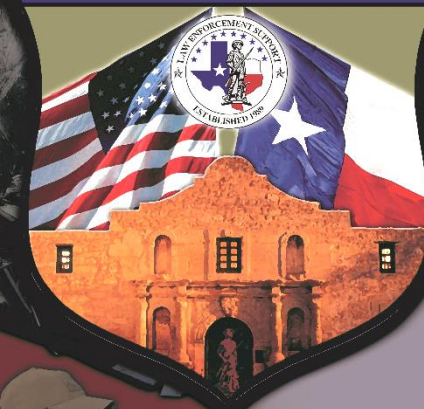

Civil Operations Support

The Texas JCDTF and its state and local partners seek to improve the health and well-being of Texas communities by addressing alcohol and other substance use/abuse through coalition development. The Texas JCDTF conducts Civil Operations in order to augment local anti-drug coalitions by providing technical assistance and training to create a strong response to substance abuse in Texas communities, and ensure long-term positive behavior outcomes.



On-Call Capabilities



Ground Reconnaissance and Training

Conducts low-visibility counterdrug ground reconnaissance to detect and report illegal drug activities in support of law enforcement drug interdiction operations. Ground Reconnaissance provides the following mission support:

- Case Support
- Area and Route Reconnaissance
- Air to Ground (A2G) Down-link
- Reconnaissance Coordination
- Basic Military Training to Law Enforcement

Army Aviation Support

Provides aerial rotary wing support at no cost to law enforcement:

- Aerial Thermal Imaging Camera with data downlink capabilities & aerial Command and Control Platform with secure communications
- Transportation and Tactical Logistics
- Basic Military Training to Law Enforcement
- Aerial Area and Route Reconnaissance
