**CAPACITY:** Define and build resources and readiness.

**PLANNING:** Propose strategies and devise actions to be taken.

**IMPLEMENTATION:** Carry out processes necessary to completing the plan.

**EVALUATION:** Assess effectiveness of outcomes.
