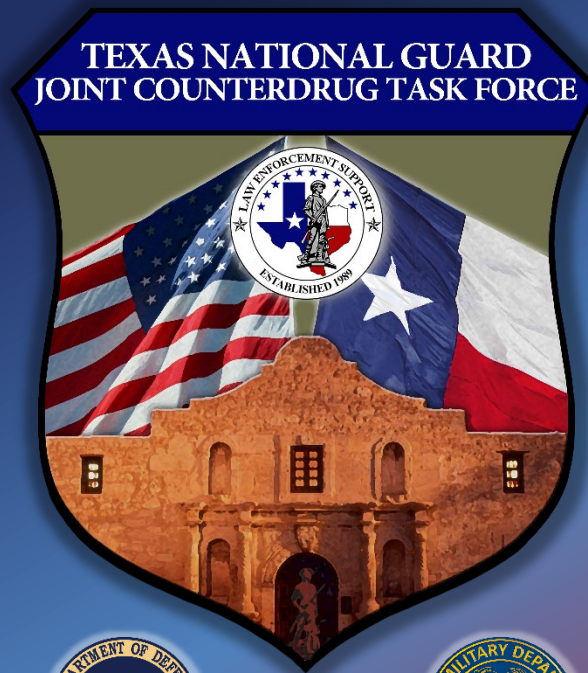
Additional Support Capabilities

REGION NORTH provides support to vicinities that include, but are not limited to: Austin, Dallas / Fort Worth and the Texoma High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area region.

REGION SOUTH provides support to vicinities that include, but are not limited to: Laredo, San Antonio and the Southwest Border South Texas High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area region.

REGION EAST provides support to vicinities that include, but are not limited to: Brownsville, McAllen, Corpus Christi, Houston and the Houston High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area region.

REGION WEST provides support to vicinities that include, but are not limited to: El Paso, Midland and the Southwest Border West Texas High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area region.

Analysis Support Mission

The Texas National Guard Joint Counterdrug Task Force Analysis Support members enhance the capabilities of law enforcement agencies by leveraging unique military skills and training to establish analytical systems and databases, and support the development of Transnational Criminal Drug Trafficking Organizations investigations and drug-nexus criminal cases.

Analysis Support Duties

CREATION of graphs, charts, maps and toll analysis of suspected individuals or organizations.

ASSISTANCE in the design, development and daily maintenance of criminal databases; compilation, review and input of raw data.

PREPARATION of reports necessary for successful investigational and prosecutorial purposes.

PERFORMANCE of necessary case research.

DAILY UTILIZATION of analyst-specific law enforcement agency software and hardware systems.

COORDINATED DISSIMINATION of criminal information, and conducting strategic and tactical analysis of case information.
