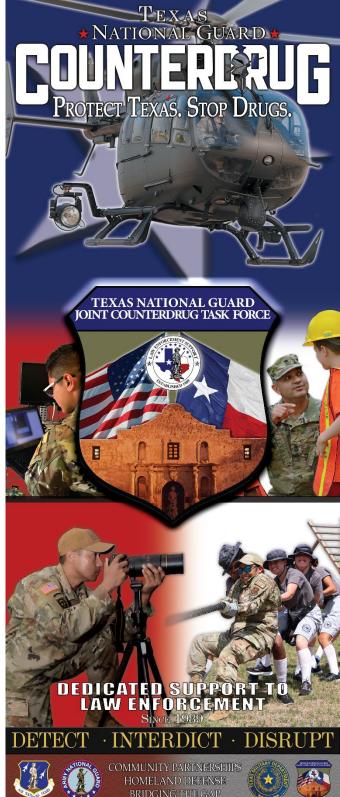

Drug Demand Reduction Outreach Program

Through support of the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) and other federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies and partners, the Texas National Guard Joint Counterdrug Task Force Drug Demand Reduction Outreach program provides militarily unique skills bringing innovations to address the ever-growing threat of substance abuse and misuse facing Texas communities, including the growing fentanyl crisis. This is accomplished through science-based prevention and education training, leveraging community partners, and networking resources from the national down to the local level in order to effect a positive change in communities.

Ground Reconnaissance and Training

Conducts low-visibility counterdrug ground reconnaissance to detect and report illegal drug activities in support of law enforcement drug interdiction operations. Ground Reconnaissance provides the following mission support:

- Air to Ground (A2G) Down-link
- Reconnaissance Coordination
- Basic Military Training to Law Enforcement



Army Aviation Support
