GENERAL: The Texas Military Department invites the nomination of a highly qualified Aviation Branch Warrant Officer to serve as a CH-47D instructor pilot for the Republic of Singapore Air Force (RSAF) Training Detachment.

HOW TO APPLY: Title 10 personnel need to send a DA Form 4187, Request for Personnel Action, through channels, to apply and contact the Texas State Aviation Recruiter, CW2 Christopher Cordero. Title 32 AGR and M-day applicants must include a letter of transmittal from State personnel officer, including the following information:

DA 160R (Application for Active Duty Packets cannot be considered if the DA 160R is not signed by the applicant)

Certified and current 2-1 Officer Record Brief

Letter of Intent to separate from Active Duty, USAR or M-day status. DD214 if Applicable

Copies of last 3 OERs

Most recent SF88 (Physical Examination)/ SF93/MEDPROS along with a current and qualified medical recommendation for flying (4186) including a written justification of waivers if applicable.

DA Form 705 and DA Form 5500-R if applicable (within 6 months)

NGB 23A or DD214 to verify creditable active federal service (AFS)

Secret Clearance (approved investigation and clearance) date and type of investigation

DA Form 759 and complete copies of flight records

Short biographical sketch giving brief personal background and highlighting qualifications for this position.

Pilot CH/ICH 47 aircraft under all types of meteorological conditions in all modes of flight Day, Night and NVD

Perform instructor pilot duties, conduct academic and in flight aircrew training to personnel assigned to the RSAF Training Detachment

Conduct qualification training, Commander's evaluations, APARTs and no-notice evaluations in CH/ICH-47 aircraft

Assist, develop and manage a performance oriented, technically demanding, standardized Aircrew Training Program (ATP). Assist in the administration of the unit through evaluation, training and technical supervision of unit ATP.

PREREQUISITES:

Grade: Warrant Officer (all grades)

Branch: Aviation

MOS/SSI 154CC/CF/CH

Applicant must be a CH-47 rated instructor pilot. Instrument Examiner or Standardization Pilot preferred.

Military Education: Commensurate with grade

Civilian Education: Commensurate with grade

Must have thorough knowledge of aviation policies, procedures, organizations and operations.

Applicants must meet the qualifications listed in Table 2-1, AR 135-18 or be able to qualify for a waiver IAW NGB-ARH Policy Memo #09—021

Applicants must meet the height and weight standard of AR 600-9

All selective active duty and USAR officers will need to voluntarily separate and be assessed in the TXARNG prior to accession into the RSAF Flight Training Detachment

Applicants must possess a SECRET Security Clearance
