 - b) If the application is not sent to ng.tx.txarng.mbx.trp@mail.mil, it may not be received by the deadline which could disqualify the applicant from receiving a tuition award.

II. Deadlines

- **1. Application Form**. There are 2 separate submission deadlines:
 - a) January 15 is the primary deadline for all applicants.
 - Applications received by this deadline are eligible for the standard award up to 6 credits of tuition and mandatory fees, not to exceed \$2,250.
 - Additionally, the applicant qualifies to request the High Need Exemption (HNE) from the 6 credit award limit.
 - The HNE allows consideration for an award of up to 12 credits of tuition and mandatory fees, not to exceed \$4,500. See page 5 of this application for more details and to fill out the HNE request.
 - All applicants are encouraged to submit applications before this deadline.
 - b) February 05 is the extended deadline to submit applications.
 - Applications received in our office by this deadline will <u>be eligible to receive the standard award.</u>
 - The standard award is for up to 6 credits of tuition and mandatory fees, not to exceed \$2,250.
 - c) All awards are subject to availability of funds, regardless of how early the application is submitted. Award amounts are not guaranteed. Final award amounts are determined after final grades are confirmed.
- 2. February 26 is the deadline for all Additional Document. You do not need to submit additional documents together with your application. This includes your course schedule and fee statement.
 - a) Any additional documents that are required can be submitted separately from the application form. This will allow time to acquire needed documents.
 - b) Two items that are required for all applicants are a course schedule and a fee statement.
 - A fee statement should show amount for tuition, fees, and financial aid payments.
 - A "payment receipt" is not acceptable unless it includes the above information.
 - c) As soon as your schedule is set (after the add/drop period), email your course schedule and fee statement to ng.tx.txarng.mbx.trp@mail.mil.
 - d) Other documents that may be required include: FTA form, 9/11 GI Bill Certificate Letter, financial aid letter, etc.
 - e) Tuition awards may not be approved without these documents.
- 3. June 04 is the deadline for transcripts.
 - a) You must send in an Official Transcript to confirm passing grades for your tuition award.
 - b) **ONLY OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS** will be accepted.
 - c) Grade reports, screen shots of online records or unofficial transcripts will **NOT** be accepted.
