Act since fall of 1995 and the program/school accepts

*Cost of tuition up to \$250 per semester hour NTE

exemption at a Texas public college or university;

TXARNG only. Must:

*currently serve in the TXARNG.

*not be flagged. *have a common access card (CAC).

*Up to \$4,000 per fiscal year to pay for training, materials, textbooks, study guides and test fees leading to a credential on the Army COOL website. *Does not have to be related to MOS. *Can use both FTA and CA however.

the **combined** usage shall not exceed \$4,000 per FY.
