

POSITION INFORMATION AND ELIGIBILITY

POSITION TITLE: 71st Troop Command (71TC) Command Sergeant Major

ANTICIPATED START DATE: No earlier than 01 February 2018, or upon return from deployment.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: The Command Sergeant Major is the 71TC Commander's principal advisor on all enlisted matters of the 71st Troop Command. This position will be filled by a Texas Army National Guard Sergeant Major (E9).

Additionally, this position is nominative, and the 71TC Commanding General will select his candidate from the applicants.

DUTY LOCATION AND EMPLOYMENT TYPE: This position is M-Day with a duty location at Bee Caves Armory, in Austin, TX. If a lateral appointment is necessary, individuals will also have to meet specific requirements for lateral appointment to CSM in accordance with AR 600-8-19 and NGR 600-200.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION:

Applicants who do not meet ALL areas of the minimum criteria will not be considered.

1. All Army E9s (M-day, Title 32 AGR, Dual-Status Technicians, Title 10 AGR, or T10 mobilized) are encouraged to apply.
2. Applicant must be a graduate of the United States Army Sergeant Major Academy and must have completed SSD5.
3. The term of service of the Troop Command CSM position is based on the needs of the organization and will be reviewed annually with the 71TC Commander.
4. Applicant must be currently deployable for any Title 10 mission.
5. Preferably, the applicant has deployed within the last 5 years.
6. Applicant must have served as and been rated as a First Sergeant. Must currently serve or have served for an O6 or above command and have served at least one (1) tour at an O5 level command. Preferably, the applicant will have served while deployed at the BDE or BN level.
7. Applicant must possess a minimum of a SECRET security clearance and be eligible for Top Secret-SCI.
9. Applicant must meet the APFT and HT/WT standards in accordance with FM 7-22 (Army Physical Readiness Training) and AR 600-9 (Army Weight Control Program).
10. Applicant must have operations and administration experience.
11. Applicant must be eligible for retirement (regular or non-regular) without exceeding age 60 at the end of the tour.
