

POSITION INFORMATION AND ELIGIBILITY

POSITION TITLE: 136th Regiment Command Sergeant Major

ANTICIPATED START DATE: No earlier than 01 May 2018, or upon return from deployment.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: The Command Sergeant Major is the 136th Regiment principal advisor on all enlisted matters of the 136th Regiment, as well as Commandant for all NCOES courses taught by the 136th Regiment. This position will be filled by a Texas Army National Guard Sergeant Major (E9). (Any MOS may apply)

DUTY LOCATION AND EMPLOYMENT TYPE: This position is AGR with a duty location at Fort Hood, TX. If a lateral appointment is necessary, individuals will also have to meet specific requirements for lateral appointment to CSM in accordance with AR 600-8-19 and NGR 600-200.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION:

Applicants who do not meet ALL areas of the minimum criteria will not be considered.

1. All Army E9s (M-day, Title 32 AGR, Dual-Status Technicians, Title 10 AGR, or T10 mobilized) are encouraged to apply. M-day applicants, if selected, will be placed on a three (3) year One Time Occasional Tour (OTOT) order.
2. Applicant must be a graduate of the United States Army Sergeant Major Academy.
3. Applicant must be currently deployable for any Title 10 mission.
4. Applicant must possess a minimum of a SECRET security clearance and be eligible for Top Secret-SCI.
5. IAW AR 350-1, Appendix F, Soldiers centrally selected for command positions and CSM designees, regardless of age, must have a Cardiovascular Screening Program (CVSP), meet body composition standards set forth in AR 600-9, and pass the three-event APFT or APFT using an alternate aerobic event before assuming command or assignment to a CSM position. A CVSP clearance granted during the Soldier's last periodic health assessment is sufficient to meet the CVSP requirement.
6. Applicant must have operations and administration experience.
