1. All Army E9s (M-day, Title 32 AGR, Dual-Status Technicians, Title 10 AGR, or T10 mobilized) are encouraged to apply. M-day applicants, if selected, will be placed on a three (3) year One Time Occasional Tour (OTOT) order.

2. Applicant must be a graduate of the United States Army Sergeant Major Academy.

3. Applicant must be currently deployable for any Title 10 mission.

4. Applicant must possess a minimum of a SECRET security clearance and be eligible for Top Secret-SCI.

5. IAW AR 350-1, Appendix F, Soldiers centrally selected for command positions and CSM designees, regardless of age, must have a Cardiovascular Screening Program (CVSP), meet body composition standards set forth in AR 600-9, and pass the threeevent APFT or APFT using an alternate aerobic event before assuming command or assignment to a CSM position. A CVSP clearance granted during the Soldier's last periodic health assessment is sufficient to meet the CVSP requirement.

6. Applicant must have operations and administration experience.
