<u>POSITION DESCRIPTION:</u> The Command Sergeant Major is the principal advisor on all enlisted matters within the BN/BDE. The positions will be filled by Texas Army National Guard Sergeants Major (E9) or promotable First Sergeants/Master Sergeants (E8). (Any MOS may apply for potential placement on the Enlisted Leader Order of Merit list.)

<u>DUTY LOCATION AND EMPLOYMENT TYPE:</u> The positions are MDAY in various locations throughout the state. If a lateral appointment is necessary, individuals will also have to meet specific requirements for lateral appointment to CSM in accordance with AR 600-8-19 and NGR 600-200.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION:

Applicants who do not meet ALL areas of the minimum criteria will not be considered.

- 1. All eligible Army E9s (M-day, Title 32 AGR, Dual-Status Technicians, Title 10 AGR, or T10 mobilized) are encouraged to apply.
- 2. E9 applicants must be graduates of, or currently enrolled in, the United States Army Sergeant Major Course (SMC). If not currently enrolled in SMC, E8 applicants must meet all requirements for enrollment.
- 3. Applicants must be currently deployable for any Title 10 mission.
- 4. Applicants must possess a minimum of a SECRET security clearance and be eligible for Top Secret-SCI.
- 5. IAW AR 350-1, Appendix F, Soldiers centrally selected for command positions and CSM designees, regardless of age, must have a Cardiovascular Screening Program (CVSP), meet body composition standards set forth in AR 600-9, and pass the three-event APFT or APFT using an alternate aerobic event before assuming command or assignment to a CSM position. A CVSP clearance granted during the Soldier's last periodic health assessment is sufficient to meet the CVSP requirement.
- 6. Operations and administration experience is preferred.
- 7. Applicants selected for a CSM position are subject to a mandatory Personnel Suitability Screening and must be appointed by HQDA CSM board prior to their 57th birthday.
