## **Texas National Guard partners with international armed forces for annual Best Warrior Competition**

AUSTIN, Texas (Feb. 28, 2017) – On Saturday, March 4, 2017 from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., the Texas Military Department will host a media day at Camp Swift in Bastrop, Texas, near Austin, as 28 Texas National Guard soldiers and airmen, Czech and Chilean armed forces members compete in the final round of the statewide Best Warrior Competition.

Immediately following a 12-mile foot march, the competitors will gather as the Bastrop County Commissioner reads an official resolution celebrating the contributions of the local military and its service members, as well as renewing Bastrop's support of the TMD Best Warrior Competition. After the proclamation by Bastrop officials, media representatives are invited to cover the "mystery event," a fastpaced, high-intensity event that will test all competitors on numerous warrior tasks.

The Best Warrior Competition is a rigorous three-day competition that tests the tactical and technical expertise of service members through scored events, such as an oral knowledge exam board, a tactical road march, obstacle course and physical fitness test, as well as "a mystery event" announced the day of the competition.

For the first time, representatives from Texas' State Partnership Program countries of the Czech Republic and Chile will be competing in this event. The purpose is to build camaraderie and strengthen interagency relationships between Texas Guardsmen and those they serve alongside of both at home and abroad.

The winners of this year's Best Warrior competition will be named and honored at an upcoming banquet in April. Winners from the Army National Guard will continue to represent Texas in regional and/or national Best Warrior competitions later this year. The mission of the Texas Military Department (TMD) is to provide the Governor and the President with ready and trained forces in support of the citizens of Texas and State and Federal civil/military authorities at home and abroad.

The Texas Military Department is commanded by the Adjutant General of Texas, the state's senior military official appointed by the governor, and is comprised of the Texas Military Department (formerly the Adjutant General's Department), the Texas Army National Guard (TXARNG), the Texas Air National Guard (TXANG), the Texas State Guard (TXSG) and the Domestic Operations Command (DOMOPS).
