**AUSTIN, Texas (April 19, 2018)** The Texas Military Department and Camp Mabry, in Austin, Texas, will host its annual open house from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., this Saturday and Sunday, April 21-22, 2018. The event will feature the American Heroes Show.

The free two-day event will feature a variety of military vehicles and equipment on display, a helicopter show, parachute jump team, the Traveling Vietnam Wall, a World War II reenactment, local first responder demonstrations, and many other events.

The event will also highlight the crucial role of helicopters in law enforcement, public safety, urban search and rescue and National Guard support to civil authorities in domestic operations through aerial demonstrations, weather dependent.
