1. Fill out the attached form.
2. Mail, fax or email form to the below listed contacts along with supporting documents.
IE: investigation was unfounded or supporting letters stating you are no longer that type of Soldier.
3. Once the request is received by the records department you will receive a notification of your request being received.
4. After 20 days if you don't receive a response approving or denying your request you will receive a new notification letting you know more time is needed to decide your disposition.
