Serves as the Senior Enlisted Advisor to the DIVARTY Commander and staff on all matters pertaining to enlisted Soldiers, and their families. Responsible for enforcing established policies and standards for enlisted Soldiers pertaining to performance, care, conduct, appearance, effective personnel utilization, management and training. Ensures that subordinate NCOs provide outstanding leadership, guidance on NCOES and NCODP, assess training at all levels and provides feedback to appropriate commanders and leaders. On order the CSM is prepared to assist in the planning, coordination and execution of federal missions and state emergencies as directed.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

- 1. Must be able to communicate effectively and efficiently in both verbal and written communication.
- 2. Must be able to Interstate Transfer to the Texas Army National Guard.
- 3. Must be able to attend monthly IDT, 2 weeks of Annual Training, Quarterly Enlisted Talent Management Advisory Committee, and all other training exercises (as required).
- 4. Must be able to Deploy and maintain a "Deployable Status" through the entirety of the tour.
