## QRP Fact Sheet: Excluded Items

Scrap dealers, recyclers and members of the public should be familiar with the types of items and materials prohibited from sale through the Qualified Recycling Program (QRP).

**Excluded Items** may sometimes find their way into the waste and recycling streams. These items should not be thrown away or recycled, as they could end up in unregulated markets or in the hands of our adversaries.

For some items, the value to our adversaries is in the metallurgy or design, so complete, functioning items are not required

There *are* legitimate sources for surplus military parts and equipment, but they should never be among scrap or recycled materials.

## QRP Fact Sheet: Excluded Items

This list of **excluded items** includes materials that scrap dealers and recyclers might encounter at armories and training areas throughout the state. Excluded item lists are never comprehensive, so be on the lookout for things that don't look right. Just because it looks like scrap, does not mean it is scrap.

- Material that can be sold as a usable item, reusable or repairable items, such as used parts from vehicles or machines
- Reusable ammunition cans and ammunition boxes
- Fuels
- HAZMAT and ozone depleting substances
- Unopened containers of solvent, paint, or oil
- Incendiary products
- General Services Administration (GSA) equipment
- Lost, abandoned, or unclaimed privately owned personal property
- Reusable wooden pallets

- Precious-metal bearing scrap
- Consecrated religious devices
- Drugs, biological, and controlled substances
- DoD inspection stamps and equipment
- Electrical and electronic components
- Items subject to U.S. Trade Security Controls, to include *Munitions List Items* (MLI) *Commerce Control List Items* (CCLI)
- Aircraft, weapons, or other material requiring demilitarization prior to sale, and scrap resulting from the DMIL process
