SUBJECT: TXSG Maximum Age Waiver Policy

Reference. Texas Government Code 437, Subchapter G, Texas State Guard

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. This instruction provides guidance with respect to the maximum age for service in the TXSG. It also provides procedures for requesting an extension past the maximum age for service.
- 2. <u>APPLICABILITY AND SCOPE</u>. This instruction applies to all TXSG personnel
- 3. DEFINITIONS. NA.
- 4. <u>DIRECTIVE/POLICY</u>. Pursuant to Texas Government Code 437.302, to serve in the Texas State Guard a person must not be older than 70 years of age.
- a. Members will be discharged on the date of their 70th birthday, unless an extension has been submitted through T-1 and approved by the Deputy Commanding General, TXSG.
 - b. Extension Request Procedure:
 - (1) Requested using standard memorandum format through T1 to DCG.
- (2) Request must be based on unique skills and/or operational experience not otherwise replicated in the TXSG and not immediately replaceable.
- (3) Signed by the first O-5 or above in the chain of command and submitted 90 days prior to the member's 70th birthday. Send to the T-1 Discharge email box, discharge@txsg.state.tx.us.
- (4) If approved, extension may allow for continued service in the Texas State Guard for up to, but not to exceed, the member's 71st birthday, in which time a replacement is expected to be trained and developed for the position.
- 5. <u>RESPONSIBILITIES</u>. Leaders at all levels will disseminate and ensure adherence to this instruction.

- 6. <u>INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS</u>. NA.
- 7. <u>RELEASABILITY</u>. Unlimited.
- 8. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This instruction will expire 2 years from the effective date of publication unless sooner rescinded or superseded.
