SUBJECT: Change Affecting E-4 Specialist/Corporal Grade

References. FM 1-0, Human Resources Support, 1 April 2014

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. This instruction re-establishes the Specialist rank in the Texas State Guard. The Specialist rank will be awarded to personnel promoted to E-4 in the Texas state guard as well as personnel that enlist in the organization with college degrees.
- 2. <u>APPLICABILITY AND SCOPE</u>. This policy applies only to E4 Corporals and Specialists
- 3. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>. NA
- 4. <u>DIRECTIVE/POLICY</u>.
  - a. Having Corporals in leadership positions and Specialists in non-leadership positions will motivate our personnel to achieve the status of NCO. All current Corporals will keep their rank, and going forward—effective 01 SEP 2023—all E4 advancements/enlistments will be to the rank of Specialist.
  - (1) TXSG Reg 1051.1 para 4-3 a(3)(b) amended to read "This regulation requires all personnel promoted to E4 to hold the rank of Specialist."
  - (2) An E4 Specialist, while holding the same grade as a Corporal, will not be assigned to a leadership position.
  - (3) Unit mentoring and training programs can prepare the Specialist for a leadership position upon promotion to E5.

- (4) Personnel excelling in those programs can be laterally appointed as Corporals and assigned to leadership MTOE positions, following a board at the local level and concurrence by the Brigade and TXSG Command Sergeants Major.
- 5. RESPONSIBILITIES. All TXSG leaders will enforce the guidance in this instruction.
- 6. INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS. NA
- 7. RELEASABILITY. Unlimited.
- 8. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This instruction will expire 2 years from the effective date of publication unless sooner rescinded or superseded.
