SUBJECT: Fire Guard Requirements for all Texas Military Department (TMD) Managed Facilities

## 1. <u>REFERENCES.</u>

- a. National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 101 Life Safety Code.
- b. Unified Facilities Criteria (UFC) 3-600-1, Fire Protection Engineering for Facilities, 08AUG16.
  - c. Army Regulation 420-2, Army Facilities Management, 24AUG12.
- 2. <u>PURPOSE</u>. To provide fire safety guidance for the establishment of a "Fire Guard" at TMD facilities.
- 3. <u>APPLICABILITY AND SCOPE.</u> This directive applies to all TMD facilities and any Armed Forces Reserve Centers (AFRC) managed by TMD.

## 4. DEFINITIONS. N/A

- 5. <u>POLICY</u>. All TMD units will implement a Fire Guard when Service Members reside overnight at a TMD facility during Inactive Drill Training and Annual Training. This requirement is only for TMD facilities that do not have a fire protection system installed, not functioning properly, damaged, destroyed or offline due to repairs.
- 6. <u>INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS.</u> Units are responsible for maintaining Fire Guard logs and submitting logs to the TMD Fire Marshal.
- 7. RELEASABILITY. Unlimited.
- 8. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE.</u> This directive will expire two years from the effective date of publication unless sooner rescinded or superseded.
