MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: (JFTX I15-18) Texas Military (TXM) Strategic Framework Implementation

1. Purpose. The purpose of this memorandum is to communicate intent for implementation of the TXM Strategic Framework and to describe the initiatives to be utilized to ensure success.

2. Background. In June 2015 the Adjutant General (TAG) and Deputy Adjutants General (DAGs) provided guidance for continued review and refinement of the TXM Strategic Framework, to include the strategy and planning cycle. This guidance defined the goals and objectives within the TXM Strategic Framework.

3. Initiatives.

a. First, the Strategic Framework Council needs to be created. The Council refines products produced by the Strategic Framework Working Group for presentation to TAG at the semi-annual Strategic Framework Board. The Council will also set planning timelines and attendance requirements. The following senior leaders are appointed to the Strategic Framework Council:

- 1) Chief of Staff, TXARNG
- 2) Chief of Staff, TXANG
- 3) Chief of Staff, TXSG
- 4) Chief of Staff, DOMOPS
- 5) Chief of Staff, Texas Military Department
- 6) Director, Strategic Initiatives Group (SIG)

b. Second, the Strategic Framework Working Group needs to be created. The Working Group works at the direction of the Council and produces action plans and methods for review and approval. The Strategic Framework Council has delegation appointment authority to select working group members.

c. The Working Group is led and organized by the SIG. Chiefs of Staff will select members from primary staff sections and major subordinate units who will play a key role in the development of component action plans and policy. Selections must be deliberate to ensure a dedicated and reliable participant. Provide names and contact information of selected personnel directly to the SIG.

4. It is extremely important that we build and sustain momentum toward achieving TAG vision. I understand stakeholders' concerns about our TXM Strategic Framework becoming a huge document that does nothing but sit on a shelf. That is exactly the reason for launching these initiatives – to enable TXMF components and TMD to own the plan. The expectation is not a rewrite of the existing component strategic plans. However, component plans must not contradict anything in the TXM Strategic Framework and action plans at the component level should focus on achieving the priorities and goals of the TXM Strategic Framework.
