- Develop the Skills to be a Leader
  - OCS is an intense leadership training course
  - It's physically and mentally challenging
  - Not for everyone
- Understanding the History of OCS
  - Need based program
  - Original Design 1940, WWII
  - 1951, Korean War
  - Enduring legacy, consistent mission

#### Where: Fort Moore, GA Length: 12 Weeks

When: Offered year-around

Who:

- 1. Non-Prior Service
- 2. Prior Service Navy
- 3. Prior Service Air Force

Age: 18–33 (Must completed FOCS before  $34^{th}$  Birthday)

#### Education: Bachelor's Degree



## STATE OCS

Where: Camp Swift, TX Length: 12 months

#### When: One Weekend / Month

- Phase 0: APR MAY
- Phase I: JUNE 2 Weeks
- Phase II: JUL FEB
- Phase III: MAR 2 Weeks
- Graduation: APRIL (Tentative)

#### Who:

- 1. Non-Prior Service (09S)
- 2. Prior Service

Age: 18-42 (Must commission by 42<sup>nd</sup> Birthday)

Education: 90 hrs towards a Bachelor's Degree

### ACCELERATED

Where: Ft. McClellan, AL / Ft. Meade, SD Length: 8 Weeks

#### When: Summer (AOCS)

- State Phase 0: APR MAY

### ARMY ATIONAL SUARD \* OFFICER CANDIDATE SCHOOL

Officer Strength Management, Basic Branch is the proponent

- MDAY vs AGR vs ADOS
- Physical Fitness validation (4 mile run and 12 mile ruck)

Limited by Funding

- Winter (beginning of Fiscal Year 10 Seats)
- Summer (end of Fiscal Year 5 Seats)

Physically Demanding

- 60 days no rest
- Most failures due to physical

Can be utilized to complete previous phase drops

- No direct roll-overs (SOCS ->AOCS)
- 2 Year deadline to complete all phases

## **Expected Pay**

- E-5 or above during OCS
- 2LT (O vs O-E; years of service)
  O-E= 1460 pts or 4 YRS AFS
- Increase in BAH
- Loss of BAS
- Loss of Annual Clothing Allowance
- Advancement to 1LT at 18 months
- Promotion to Captain 2-5 years.

Training Lengths

- OCS
- BOLC (3-9 months)
- Captains Career Course

## OFFICER CANDIDATE SCHOOL TRAINING PATH

### BASIC COMBAT TRAINING (BCT)

• 10 Weeks

• Fort Moore / Fort Jackson / Fort Sill / Fort Leonard Wood

### OFFICER CANDIDATE SCHOOL (OCS)

FOCS: 12 Weeks

SOCS: 12 Months (Typically April thru March)

AOCS: 8 Weeks (Same pre-requirements as SOCS, January thru March OR June thru July)

### BASIC OFFICER LEADERS COURSE (BOLC)

- Length / Location of course dependent on Branch/Area of Concentration (AOC); 3 months to 9 months
- Scheduled by gaining TXARNG unit after the completion of OCS

Note\*

- Cannot be placed on Federal Orders until BOLC (exc. AGR)
- Can be placed on State Active Duty



## OFFICER CANDIDATE SCHOOL BRANCHING

Branching / Area of Concentration is managed by the TXARNG Officer Personnel Management (OPM) Team:

- Officers are evaluated for branch assignment based on:
  - Branch Density / Officer Assignment Strength
  - Class Ranking
  - Officer Candidate's Branch Preferences
  - Officer Candidates Home of Record
  - Officer Candidates Background (Major, Civilian Career, GPA)

## OFFICER CANDIDATE SCHOOL QUALIFICATIONS

### State OCS / Accelerated OCS Qualifications: NGR 600-100

- Age: Between 18 and 41 years old
- U.S. Citizen (Born or Naturalized)
- <u>90 College Semester Hours</u> towards a 4 Year Degree and approved degree plan
- Eligible for a Secret Security Clearance (Interim)
- General Technical Score of 110 on the Armed Services Aptitude Battery exam
- Chapter 2 Commissioning Physical, No ACFT Alternate Events
- Occupational Physical Assessment Test

### Start OCS Course

- Waivers complete: Moral / Medical; no active evaluations or legal cases

### **OCS Course Completion**

- COE (up to 5 years): Incentives, ADOS, AGR, Personal
- Security Clearance conferred
- Federal Recognition packet
