WHAT IS OCS?

Develop the Skills to be a Leader

- OCS is an intense leadership training course
- It's physically and mentally challenging
- Not everyone is cut out for it
- OCS will transform you into an effective leader

State OCS / Accelerated OCS Qualifications:

- Age: Between 18 and 41 years old
- U.S. Citizen (Born or Naturalized)
- 90 College Semester Hours towards a 4 Year Degree and approved degree plan
- Eligible for a Secret Security Clearance (Interim)
- General Technical Score of 110 on the Armed Services Aptitude Battery exam
- Chapter 2 Commissioning Physical Occupational Physical Assessment Test

Training Options

TRADITIONAL STATE OCS

Where: Camp Swift, TX

Length: 12 months

When: One Weekend / Month

- Phase 0: APR – MAY
- Phase I: JUNE – 2 Weeks
- Phase II: JUL – FEB
- Phase III: MAR – 2 Weeks
- Graduation: APRIL (Tentative)

ACCELERATED OCS

Where: Ft. McClellan, AL / Ft. Meade, SD

Length: 8 Weeks

When:

Summer (AOCS)

- State Phase 0: APR – MAY
- PH I/II/III: JUN-JUL
- Graduation: AUGUST

Winter (AOCS)

- PH I/II/III: JAN-MAR
- Graduation: MARCH

*Not guaranteed. Priority for age 41 and geographically dispersed.
