## Some Idiot Math

List your current age
List # of years you have been a technician/federal civilian
List # of years you served on Active Duty, if any (Mil Buyback)
List # of years of service (when #2 + #3 = 25)
List # of years of creditable service you'll have at age 50
List # of years of creditable service you'll have at age 57

## Optional Retirement Eligibility ("Your Choice")

- Minimum Retirement Age (MRA) + 30 years of creditable service

- a) MRA is age 57 if your birth year is 1970 or after
- b) If your birth year is before 1970, MRA ranges from 55 to 57
- 60 yrs old & 20 yrs of creditable service OR 62 yrs old & 5 yrs creditable service
- Have you bought back your active duty time yet? Waiting = more interest

Discontinued Service Retirement ("The Company's Choice")

- Result of involuntary separation & <u>not</u> for cause (non-retention for force mgt)
- Mandatory Age & Service Requirements: the "50/20 or 25/any" rule.
  - a) Age 50 & 20 years of creditable service
  - b) Any age & 25 years of creditable service

Contribute to your Thrift Savings Plan!!!

- TSP is designed to make up the largest portion of your total retirement
- FERS annuity is designed to be the smallest component
- Due to government matching, contributing <u>at least 5%</u> regularly is a no-brainer
