Texas National Guard to host coordinated force protection exercise with local first responders

AUSTIN, Texas (Feb. 29, 2016) – The Texas Military Department, along with the Austin Police Department, Austin Fire Department and Austin/Travis County Emergency Medical Services will conduct a coordinated force protection training exercise at Camp Mabry, in Austin, on Thursday afternoon.

The readiness and safety of Camp Mabry personnel and the camp's civilian neighbors is a top priority of the Texas National Guard leadership. This scenario-driven training exercise will test the policies and procedures in place, enhance security, improve communication between agencies and provide valuable hands-on training necessary for Camp Mabry security and local responders to better prepare, respond and protect the camp and its surrounding areas.

Again, this is an interagency training exercise and there are no immediate threats to Camp Mabry. During this time, the post will remain open to the public, however it is possible visitors will experience service delays.
